

ARTICLE 1
ENACTMENT AND JURISDICTION

100. AUTHORITY.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by the General Statutes of South Carolina, Act No. 487 of 1967, the Town of Gilbert does ordain and enact into law the following articles and sections.

101. PURPOSE.

The purpose is to guide development in accordance with existing and future needs and in accordance with a comprehensive plan. These regulations have been made in order to protect, promote, and improve the public health, safety, morals, convenience, order, appearance, prosperity, and general welfare of the Town of Gilbert.

102. TITLE.

These regulations shall be known and may be cited as The Zoning Ordinance of Gilbert, South Carolina.

103. JURISDICTION.

The regulations set forth herein shall apply to all land and improvements thereon within the boundaries of the Town of Gilbert, South Carolina and areas annexed thereto.
